Ayako Weissman and Jon Lukomnik gave a talk titled, "The New Role of Board Director in Japan: A Global Context" on December 5, 2019. Drawing attention to a few independent directors on Japanese corporate boards, they explored the merits and demerits of both American and Japanese systems.
