Ms. Seimei gave the presentation, “Driving Lasting Transformation Through Bold Challenges,” during which she covered Monex Group’s visionary management and bold business portfolio transformation, the future of finance, Japan’s capital markets, and her career and leadership journey. Monex Group has evolved over 25 years by embracing technological change—from the Internet to blockchain—while continually challenging convention to stay one step ahead of the future. As finance moves toward a Blend-Fi model that combines traditional and decentralized elements, AI and globalization will further redefine the multi-asset landscape. In Japan, capital markets are shifting with stronger corporate governance and inflation-driven opportunities, requiring bold, risk-taking leadership. As a successor CEO with a design-thinking leadership style, Ms. Seimei described her focus on driving three core transformations while building a team ready to carry Monex Group into its next generation.
