






### **Food and Dietary Diversity**


- Traditional Korean cuisine is integral to the experience, but options may be limited for specific dietary needs (e.g., vegan, gluten-free).

#### You might need VISA

- Depending on your nationality, a visa may be required to ulletenter South Korea. We recommend checking visa <u>requirements</u> well in advance, as processing times can vary.
- Students from certain countries may need to apply for the Korea Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA). The application process can take up to 72 hours, so please plan accordingly.

#### **IS KOREA ENGLISH-FRIENDLY?**


March in Korea transitions from winter to spring, with average temperatures around 15°C (60°F) and lows of 0°C (30°F) in Seoul.
