

Policies & Things to Remember

General Policies

- Company visits are mandatory
- No shadowing or significant others
- Swapping or selling trip spots is a ~ non ~!
- You may need two visas, one for UK and one for the Schengen Area (France)
 - U.S. & EU citizens will not need visas

Timing & Matching

- 2pm Thursday Nov 14 matching begins
- 4pm Tuesday Nov 19 preference window ends
- Successful matches announced on November 20; unmatched applicants will be placed on a waitlist
 - O The \$1,000 deposit is nonrefundable
 - When offered a spot on a tour, you are dropped from all other waitlists

Eligibility

- Trip is open to full-time MBA students
- Applicants must be able to adhere to the program's guidelines and commitments
- Up to 24 spots are available
