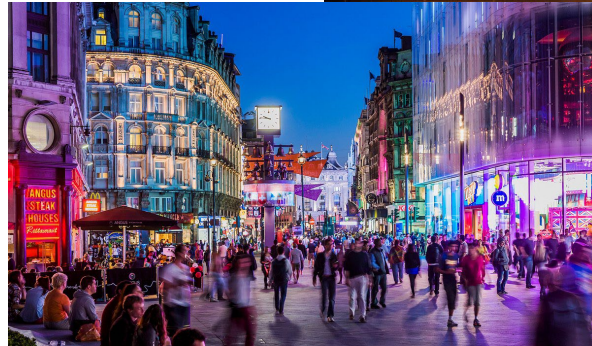

Policies & Things to Remember

General Policies

- Company visits are **mandatory**
- No **shadowing** or **significant others**
- Swapping or selling trip spots is a ~ **non** ~!
- You may need **two visas**, one for UK and one for the Schengen Area (France)
 - **U.S. & EU citizens will not need visas**

Timing & Matching

- Thursday, November 13: Matching Begins
- Tuesday, November 18 (4PM): Preference Window Ends
- Successful matches announced on Wednesday, November 19; unmatched applicants will be placed on a waitlist
 - The \$1,000 deposit is nonrefundable
 - When offered a spot on a tour, you are dropped from all other waitlists

Eligibility

- Trip is open to full-time MBA students
- Applicants must be able to adhere to the program's guidelines and commitments
- Up to 20 spots are available
