Election Policy for At Large Representative to the Executive Committee

Policy

There are two At Large representatives to the Executive Committee. The two representatives cannot be from the same division. Since the Finance and Economics is the largest division in the School, one of the At Large positions will need to be filled by a tenured faculty member from the Finance and Economics division.

Term

Only Tenured Faculty members are eligible to serve as the At Large Representative to the Executive Committee. This is a three year term and may be eligible for an additional three year term.

Nomination

Under the School's governance procedures, all tenured and tenure-track faculty and professors of practice within the School may submit nominations for both At Large seats. Anyone receiving more than two nominations and is willing to serve will be considered a candidate. If there are no other candidates, the person is automatically elected.

Election

If there is more than one candidate and all candidates are willing to serve, an election is held. All tenured and tenure-track faculty and professors of practice within the School may vote in an election. The election is conducted by paper or electronic ballot and is generally open for one week. The candidate receiving the most votes is elected.
