Before taking photos or videos, please make sure to obtain approval to capture content in these areas, ensure that proper paperwork/waivers are signed, and make sure that crews have properly vetted and have appropriate clearances.

David Geffen Hall

-Cooperman Commons - ground floor - 120

-Big modern auditorium, great natural light overlooking the square and Kravis Hall. There are solar blinds and black-out blinds to control light. Consistent light until about 12pm, then, depending on how sunny it is, lighting can change dramatically throughout the rest of the day, creating a lot of shadows and bright spots which can be used creatively.

-Alumni Suite - 2nd floor - 202

-Quiet open area with an L shaped couch, minimal natural light.

-Innovation Lab - 2nd floor - 200

-Large open space with movable tables and chairs, students often study here, good natural light overlooking the square and Kravis Hall.

-Student Lounge - 5th floor - 511

-Big busy area with floor to ceiling windows, lounge chairs, study spaces, and big staircase. Great place for capturing students and life at CBS. Usually noisy.

Henry R. Kravis Hall

-Samberg Commons - ground floor

-Big, busy, casual, colorful auditorium overlooking the square and Geffen Hall. A lot of natural light. Commonly occupied by students chatting, studying, relaxing. Noisy. The sunlight can be inconsistent in the morning until about 12pm as it can shine brightly through the windows, then in the afternoon/evening it will be more consistent.

-Student Lounge / Staircase - 4th floor - 460

-Big busy area with floor to ceiling windows, lounge chairs, study spaces, and big staircase. Great place for capturing students and life at CBS. Usually noisy.

-Student Lounge and Screening Room - 4th floor - 470

-Colorful big space, often busy with students relaxing and studying. Great natural light. Nice city views, though there is an inactive construction zone outside that may not be desirable, though you can shoot around it.

-Game Room - 4th floor - 480

-Smaller space with ping pong table and foosball table, usually occupied. Very beautiful windows overlooking city and West Side Highway structure.

-Student Lounge / Staircase - 6th floor

-Big busy area with floor to ceiling windows, lounge chairs, study spaces, and big staircase. Great place for capturing students and life at CBS. Usually noisy.

-Student Lounge / Staircase - 8th floor

-Big busy area with floor to ceiling windows, lounge chairs, study spaces, and big staircase. Great place for capturing students and life at CBS. Usually noisy.

-Executive Lounge - 10th floor - 1050

-Beautifully open space overlooking the square and Geffen Hall, with wide city views. Great natural light. Warm wood on floor and walls. Usually quiet unless an event is occurring.

-Executive Dining Room - 10th floor - 1040

-Beautifully open space often used for events, overlooking the square and Geffen Hall, with city view on one side, and the George Washington Bridge and Hudson River on the other side. Great natural light. Warm wood on floor and walls. If no event, usually empty and quiet.

-Outdoor Terrace - 10th floor - 1041

-Sweeping view of Hudson River, George Washington Bridge, New Jersey, and uptown. Usually windy.

Outside

-The Square

-Public park in between Geffen and Kravis Halls. Colorful trees in fall and spring. Lots of seating areas. There is a fountain outside of Kravis Hall that kids often play in when its hot. Mondays and Wednesdays food trucks are parked nearby (usually noisy). There are blue lounge chairs and other seating sprinkled throughout.

-Riverside Drive and West 130th Street

-This is a great location for filming the West Side Highway structure and Kravis Hall. Hudson River is nearby.

-Outside Lenfest Center for the Arts - just south of Geffen Hall

-Nice plaza to get some other Manhattanville buildings and CBS in the background

-125th Street Subway Station (the 1 train station) - Broadway and 125th street

-Above ground subway tracks with Manhattanville in the background

While these spaces are generally available throughout the day, they may be occupied at times for events, classes or other purposes.
