


What is a Great Society? (President Trump, Jan 20, 2017)

- And yes, together, we will make America **<u>GREAT</u>** again!"




When Were Americans Happiest?




Error bars: +/- 1 SE

Income Inequality in the U.S.(1946-2008)




Growing Income Inequality and its Unhappiness?



R = -.37*




Why is Income Inequality Bad?

Indirect effect = -.161, *S. E.* = .026, *z* = -6.25, *p* < .01





Why Progressive Taxation?




Why Progressive Taxation? A Psychological Mechanism



Indirect Effect, z = 5.08, p < .001


Why Against Progressive Tax? <u>Predicted</u> Happiness of the Poor & the Rich
